Qualifications and Position Responsibilities

For the full-time faculty position, at the time of employment, applicants should have a Doctoral degree in design or fine arts. The successful candidate should have experience in teaching design studios and will be expected to teach two undergraduate and/or graduate courses per semester, particularly design courses such as Basic Design and Visual Design.

For the full-time instructor position, at the time of employment, applicants should have a Masters or higher degree in design or fine arts. The successful candidate should have experience in teaching design studios and will be expected to teach three undergraduate and/or graduate courses per semester, particularly design courses such as Basic Design and Visual Design.

Also, candidates for full-time faculty and/or full-time instructor position(s) will be expected to have an active practice-based research agenda in design/fine arts, as well as to contribute and collaborate effectively in our research and teaching community. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
